What we've been working on this year:

- Omaha by Design Place Game – we have just wrapped up an exercise to determine areas for potential development and beautification. We will use these sites and ideas to guide us in our efforts both short term and long term.
- This year we have been awarded grant money from the Mayors Neighborhood grant program for a neighborhood bike rack program and Mutual of Omaha's neighborhood grant program for a streetscape prototype. We will continue to pursue grant money for the neighborhood.
